Kennebec Valley Humane Society rescues 10 puppies from near death in crowded Southern Shelter

On Friday, April 8th the Kennebec Valley Humane Society (KVHS) will have 10 puppies available for adoption that were rescued from a crowded shelter in Alabama where the puppies, if not transferred out of state, would have been euthanized. KVHS partnered with a group called Puppy Pipeline to rescue these 10 puppies in need.

“We’re happy to be able to make a difference in the lives of these animals” said Hillary Roberts, KVHS Executive Director. “We are fortunate that we have kennel space in our shelter and were able to work with a reputable group to transport these 10 puppies to our shelter where we’re confident we’ll be able to find them loving forever homes.”

Roberts says that these puppies include 4 shepherd mixes, 4 redbone hound mixes, 1 lab mix and one boxer mix. The puppies have been in the local Augusta shelter for two weeks where they have been cared for, socialized, and observed. Each of the puppies has been spayed/neutered, received routine vaccination, and has thorough health evaluations.

“Our mission is to save and improve the lives of animals- and sometimes that mission extends beyond our community or even our State,” said Roberts “There is a great need in many Southern shelters with overcrowding and dogs and puppies languishing there. When we can help, we will.”

The puppies will be available for adoption at 11am on Friday, April 8th. The adoption fee for each puppy is \$250 which includes their spay/neuter surgery and routine vaccinations.
